Dublin airport to The Dean Hotel

- by Train
 - Route: From Dublin Airport, take the Airlink Express Bus 747 or a taxi to Heuston Station in Dublin (approximately 30-45 minutes).
 - Train: Board a direct Irish Rail train from Heuston Station to Galway Ceannt Station (around 2.5 to 3 hours).
 - From Galway Ceannt Station: The Dean Hotel is a short 5-minute taxi ride or a 15-minute walk from the station.
 - Cost: Approx. €20-€35 (train fare) + bus/taxi fare.

 - Airlink Express: www.dublinbus.ie

- by Coach
 - Route: From Dublin Airport, take a direct coach service to Galway.
 - Coaches:
 - Citylink and GoBus offer frequent services from Dublin Airport directly to Galway Coach Station (around 2.5 to 3 hours).
 - From Galway Coach Station: The Dean Hotel is a short 5-minute taxi ride or a 15-minute walk from the station.
 - Cost: Approx. €20-€30 for a one-way ticket.

- by Car rental
 - Route: Rent a car at Dublin Airport and drive to Galway via the M6 motorway (approx. 2.5 to 3 hours, 210 km).

 - Parking: The Dean Hotel offers parking facilities, so you can conveniently park upon arrival.

Shanon airport to The Dean Hotel

Ireland west (knock) airport to The Dean Hotel

 - Train: From Claremorris Station, take an Irish Rail train to Galway Ceannt Station (approx. 1 hour).
 - From Galway Ceannt Station: The Dean Hotel is a short 5-minute taxi ride or a 15-minute walk.
 - Cost: Approx. €15-€25 (train + bus fare).
 - Pros: Scenic train ride, though it requires a bus/taxi transfer.
